



#### **Agile Auditing**

Monday, 27 January 2020, 8:30am—4:30pm

Through agile auditing you will improve audit delivery time, give better customer service, solve corporate problems and issues fast, and reduce delays, rework and waste. Monday, 24 February 2020, 8:30am—4:30pm



Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) - Audits Branch, Internal Audits Office is seeking a talented and motivated leader with a high level of analytical skills, strong knowledge of audit standards, and excellent verbal and written communication skills. Experience leading audit teams, reviewing work papers and conducting internal audits is desired. Under the direction of the Senior Management Auditor, the incumbent is responsible for supervising, directing, planning, and monitoring the functions and activities of auditors conducting internal audits. The incumbent must apply practices and principles of employee supervision; development and training; and consistently exercise a high degree of initiative and independence. The audits will include DMV headquarters and field offices.
